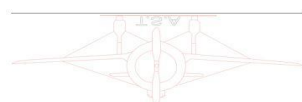


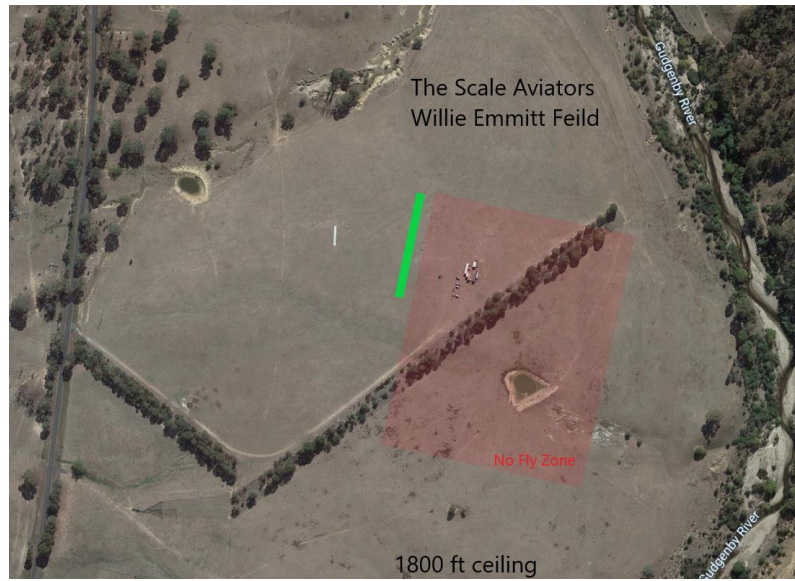
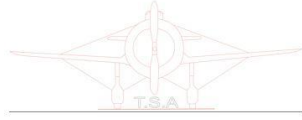
Field

- Ceiling (CASA Instrument) 1800ft.
- Grass strip North – South 140 meters by 35 meters
- Any safety or flight line issue please notify John A immediately.

Strip and Flight line

- The strip is level flat grass approximately 140 meter long by 35 meter wide with additional run off either end of over 100 meters. We have a current instrument of approval to a ceiling of 1800 feet. The field is free from obstacles. The wind is predominantly from the north which dictates anticlockwise flight circuits. On the odd occasion the wind is from the south in which case the circuits are clockwise. Generally there is no need for a flight line director due to the size of the flying area and the experience of the usual participants. If we see the need or you do for some additional controls please let us know and we will be pleased to assist. Any safety or additional questions please see John A.

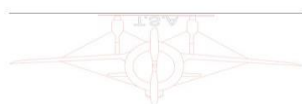


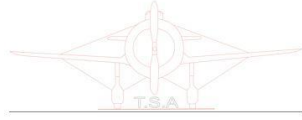


- Starting area for large aircraft

- First Aid Kit is located in the club house outside the kitchen.



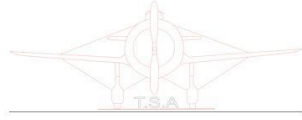
Firefighting equipment

- There is a fire blanket inside the club house just outside the kitchen



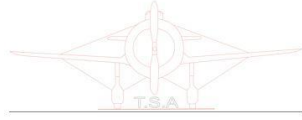
Facilities

- Power
 - We have 12v available on request.
 - We have 240 volts mains available on request:
 - The power is from the solar arrays and battery bank (Off Grid) so power demands need to be considered and managed.

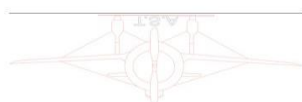


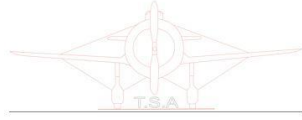
- Camping:





- Flat level grass Sites,
 - Clean male and female Toilets,
 - Hot Shower,
 - Fridge freezer available for visitors for drink in the club house,
 - Fresh ice for drinks available on request manufactured on site,
 - Ice packs available,
 - 240v is available on request,
 - Indoor heating in the club house is available on cold days and nights
 - Outdoor heating is also available on cold nights
 - Just bring your own personal equipment and camping gear.
 - Enclosed deck area and open area under cover.
 - Shade areas available under umbrellas.

- Cooling
 - There is a fridge available for the storage of your cold beverages. Please load the fridge with the requirement for the day/night so as to leave room for use by others during the weekend.
 - We have an ice maker for drinks if required.
 - Frozen water bottles are available if you need to ice for your Chilly bin.
 - Lighting
 - The Club house and veranda have lighting at night.
 - On clear nights, the stars.

- Toilets
 - There are toilets behind the club house, the two on the left are for general use and the two on the right can be made available depending on the load (See Kenny).
 - Shade and cover
 - The 12meter by 3 meter club house veranda offers good shade and shelter, in really bad weather we can install the front clear plastic windows.

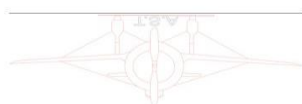


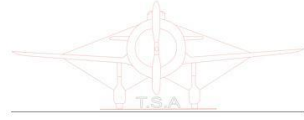


- The club house is limited access and is generally only available for dining in the colder weather, if you need access please contact John or Diane.
- There are two large umbrellas for the outside seating area which will generally be setup for the duration of an event.



- There is a large umbrella for shade out at the flight line, this will be generally set up for the duration of an event.





Cooling

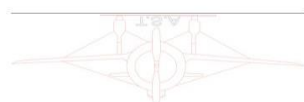
- In hot weather we have high pressure water sprayers fitted to the deck to cool down hot pilots.

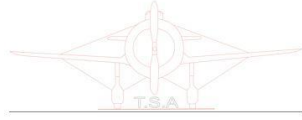


- The veranda has sliding doors both ends that can be opened to assist a cool air flow through the deck.

Heating

- In the winter the club house can be heated with a 30 K watt diesel I heater.



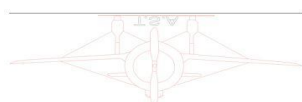


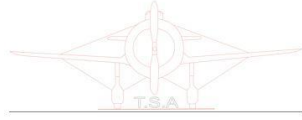
- Outside heating is adequately provided using an orchard heater



Mowing systems

- FART (Foam Aircraft Removal Technology)
 - The Robotic mower generally continues to mow during an event. Do not leave items directly in front of the clubhouse or in the taxi way. The Robotic mower has a Red emergency stop button that will shut it down if you tap it, it will generally turn around if it bumps into a solid object but can mulch aircraft better than some pilots.





- We have a standard push mover that can be used if an area needs additional mowing
- General field mowing is done with a Russian Tractor , also handy for dragging tanks and artillery guns

For Friday, Saturday and Sunday a fee of \$130.00 / head, on arrival at registration for flyers, \$90.00 for accompanying non flying partners.

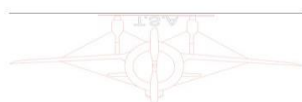
Children over 12 years will be charged adult prices for food.

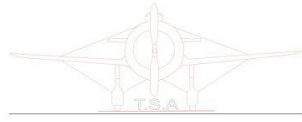
Depending on which days you attend or miss the fees can be adjusted.
